

Matskevich Irina Konstantinovna, Professor of the Department of Psychology and Correctional Pedagogy

In 1993 she graduated from the Faculty of History of the UKPI-East Kazakhstan State University, Faculty of Psychology. In 1997, she entered the graduate school of the Institute of Youth (Higher Komsomol School) in Moscow; In 2011-2012 she completed a postdoctoral fellowship at the University of L'Aquila (Italy).

Postgraduate professional education and advanced training was obtained at the University of Tartu (clinical psychology), the Moscow Institute of Clinical Psychology and Psychotherapy. The most important professional internships: Düsserldorf (clinical psychology), Cologne (organizational psychology), Deinstitutionalized Psychiatry (Italy: L'Aquila, Rome, Florence, Pisa), Institute "Imaton" St. Petersburg (Examination of parent-child relationships).

In 1993, she started working at EKSU. She worked as a teacher, senior lecturer, associate professor, head of the department, dean of the faculty, associate professor, professor of the Department of Psychology and Correctional Pedagogy. In 2007, she received the title of "The Best Teacher of Kazakhstan".

Irina Konstantinovna teaches the following disciplines: Expert counseling, Support for a family and a child with disabilities, Neuropsychology, Legal psychology, Fundamentals of psychological counseling, Social psychology, Political psychology, General psychology, Family psychology, Organizational counseling, Quality management, Modern systems in psychology, Systematic approach in psychology, Fundamentals of theoretical psychology and methodology. The quality of teaching is distinguished by exactingness, attentiveness to students, and a differentiated approach.

Matskevich I.K. actively works in the scientific direction, has publications in foreign languages, implemented several applied scientific projects.

Since 2014 - consultant, national consultant of the UN Children's Fund UNICEF. Projects "Improving the justice system for children and protecting their rights", "Children in migration processes", "Positive parenting", "Mental health of children in conflict with the law", etc.

He has been in private practice as a consultant psychologist, trainer, teacher, forensic expert since 1995.
