

The alma mater won a grant to hold events from the Goethe Institute. In 2024, the Goethe Institute in Kazakhstan will celebrate its 30th anniversary.

From September to December 2024, the events dedicated to the realization of the international project from Goethe-Institut took place in the S. Amanzholov EKU. The aim of this project is to popularize the German language and culture among schoolchildren and students, to improve the qualification of German language teachers.

As part of the project tasks, cultural and educational events were held, meetings were organized with teaching staff of the city schools and universities, round tables were held.

Within the framework of the grant, online and offline master classes were held for students of «Foreign Language: Two Foreign Languages», «Translation studies», «Russian Language and Literature». These were creative making of felt crafts for Christmas, a quiz in German dedicated to the traditions and customs of the German people, the study of Goethe's work and its modern reading, a musical evening organized jointly with students from the University of Munster "Trio Galatea" (Germany).

Master classes on learning the vocabulary of German language were held with the students of «Foreign Language: Two Foreign Languages», «Translation studies», modern educational technologies and new approaches in the methodology of teaching German language were discussed. In the online mode, the students were presented a presentation - work with texts generated by artificial intelligence, as well as creative tasks for writing essays in German.

At methodological seminars organized for teachers of city schools, university and college professors, the main problems of German language development in the region, teachers' professional development, teaching methods, game exercises for people with different levels of language skills were discussed. For novice teachers the techniques of memorizing words, modern approaches in the field of teaching methodology were demonstrated, difficulties of some grammatical constructions and game exercises to them for better learning of the material were revealed.

At the end of the project, all teachers-participants were given certificates of professional development; news with a link to the site of Goethe Institute in Kazakhstan published on the official website of Amanzholov University and in social networks Instagram, Facebook.
